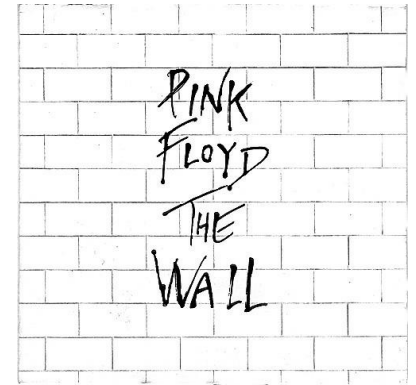


Plot Summary for Pink Floyd The Wall
